1. The meeting was called to order at 9:00 a.m. with the Pledge of Allegiance to the United States and Texas flags.

Sympathy was extended to the family of Martha Lee Peden.

The Judge commended the Boerne Fire Department, Road & Bridge crews and EMS for their concerted response in containing the 520-acre fire on Turkey Knob Road. He read a letter from the Boerne Fire Chief commending everyone's efforts and particularly EMS employee, Lissy San Miguel, for going above and beyond the call of duty.

Motion was made by Commissioner Lux, seconded by Commissioner Reissig, and carried by a vote of 5-0.

7. PUBLIC COMMENTS:

- Ken Anderson expressed concern about the County's support of the original House Bill 3265 and its
 revision that is currently before the Texas Legislature, which he says allows districts by zone and the
 creation of Planning and Zoning Commissions and requires a county to have a comprehensive plan. He
 said that even if the current Court had no desire to zone, a future Court would be enabled to do so if the
 Bill is approved.
- The County Attorney said that as the Bill is drafted now, the Court would have a hard time supporting it. He said that what the Court adopted last year was the "bare bones" Bill, which did not allow for districts, a development plan or a Planning and Zoning Commission. The people working on the Bill in Austin added those things later. Kendall County and the Hill Country Alliance want the ability to establish buffer zones for incompatible land uses, to charge the developer a fee concerning road improvements, and to regulate density.
- Dan Rogers announced that the Kendall County Economic Development Corporation, Texas Tech University, the Alamo Colleges, and the Boerne Independent School District (BISD) are creating an alliance in Kendall County to allow adults and students to receive college credit from Texas Tech and the Alamo Colleges. There is also a pilot program in the high school for students to earn up to 30 hours of college credit at Texas Tech.
- 8-a. No action was taken on lifting the burn ban; however, permits may be requested from the fire marshal.
- 9. A Public Hearing was held regarding the regulation of vehicular traffic on County roads and County-owned property. The following people spoke:
 - The County Attorney explained that vehicles are speeding in the parking areas and parking access roads and using the same for cut-through traffic. He explained the recommendations to solve the issues.
 - Shawn Bonner thanked the Court for taking The Hungry Horse Restaurant into consideration when making decisions that would reduce parking spaces for their business.
 - M.J. Slater asked the Court to keep the Chamber of Commerce in mind when making parking decisions.

an Order regulating traffic through the parking areas and parking access roads at the Courthouse and to authorize the appropriate signage. The speed limit will be posted at 10 mph. The curb at the front of the Courthouse will be designated as No Parking with the exception of an Emergency Vehicle Only Zone and a Loading Zone. The parking access road on the west side of the Courthouse will be designated No Parking or Stopping. This parking access road will have lanes for two-way traffic from East San Antonio Street to the Kendall Appraisal District (KAD) parking lot, but from the south side Courthouse parking lot going north to East San Antonio Street there will be a single lane for one-way traffic only. On Saunders Street adjacent to the Courthouse parking lot entrance, an additional No Parking area will be added.

Motion was made by Commissioner Rusch, seconded by Commissioner Lux, and carried by a vote of 5-0.

COUNTY OF KENDALL It is ordered by the Commissioners' Court of Kendall County, Texas, to establish a No Parking Zone at the Waring Volunteer Fire Department (Front Street and Waring Road).

 - James Kiehl River Bend Parks & Wildlife (TP&W) want to review the grant submission and to tour the park. Plans are underway for Park: landscaping and signage is almost complete. The tentative dedication date is Memorial Day.
- 19. No action was taken in regard to naming the new park located on Mark Twain.
- 20. Grace San Miguel, Kendall County Community Supervision and Corrections Department Director, gave an update for the Adult Probation department saying that they have outgrown their current space. She asked for an increase in space with provision for privacy during conferences and an additional bathroom.
